The role of individual differences in foreign language learning

MA Seminar description (what to expect):

The aim of the seminar is to examine reasons why some foreign language learners are more successful than others on the basis of a detailed scrutiny of selected individual differences that play a role in the foreign language learning process. These can include personality, motivation, anxiety, self-esteem, willingness to communicate or learner beliefs.

The task of the students will be to research the selected concepts:

- * theoretically on the basis of the recent literature
- * empirically by means of a qualitative and quantitative research

The thesis consists of two parts: theoretical and empirical, which are then concluded with implications for further studies and the foreign language classroom
